Meaning 'termite mound' in Swahili, Kichuguu is named after this prominent feature found all over Tarangire National Park. The camp's design has a termite mound theme with organic features and structures found throughout the camp. Enjoy gourmet Swahili cuisine with an option for western dishes.

Location : Tarangire National Park

- + 45 minute drive from the Tarangire Gate
- + 5 minute drive from Kuro Airstrip
- + Special camp site name: Njiwa camp site

- + 9 tents in king, twin, triple configuration with private verandas
- + Power point with universal adapter
- + Writing desk & digital safe
- + Morning coffee and tea butler service
- + Ensuite bathroom, flush toilet, double wash basins with running water, safari-style bucket shower
- + Distance between tents: 15 - 20 meters
- + 1 tour leader tent
